- ➤ The new Scholastic year commenced on 4 April, 2023 by invoking the assistance of the Almighty God for accompanying us in our continued journey of academic life. At the outset of the academic year to highlight the theme "Explore the new Tactics" a prayer service was conducted along with the welcome Ceremony of the children back to the School. The school has 1200 students and 60 teaching staff including a counselor, a nurse and a special educator and 15 Non-teaching staff on its roll.

Academics:

Master Anurag Tikekar of class 10th secured 94 % and four students of class 10th secured above 85 % marks. Periodic and Term exams were held regularly in the school and students bring excellent results.
