Miss Gahana Thorat of class 12th secured 96%, Master Raj Sagore 95.40% in commerce stream, Miss Anusha Singh Panwar bagged 95.40% in science stream and nine students of class 12th Secured above 90% marks. Master Shreyas Jaiswal of class 10th secured 96% and seven students of class 10th secured above 90% marks.
- ➤ The School Manager Rev. Sr. Archana and the principal Rev. Sr. Vincy Congratulated and appreciated the Students for their outstanding performance and the Staff for their efforts to lift our school to the height of the blue Sky with 100% result in classes X and XII.

Examinations:

Besides the regular exams, School also conduct competitive exams such as Olympaid, Bharatiya Sanskriti Gyan Pariksha, International painting, art and stamp making.
